



Helmet Policy

Due to the nature of sailing, there is a chance that the boom may cross the boat suddenly and cause a head injury. This is especially true of beginners, so in the interest of safety, Cransley Sailing Club recommends that all sailors adhere to the Helmet Policy.

All sailors under the age of 16 who are taking part in a training course and have not yet achieved the RYA youth sailing scheme stage 2 are required to wear protective headgear whilst sailing if instructed to do so by an Instructor

The Senior Instructor will review the weather conditions throughout the session and should conditions dictate the Senior Instructor will instruct students to wear headgear for their own protection. Should a student refuse, they will not be able to go on the water until the Senior Instructor decides that headgear can be taken off if a student wishes to do so.
