DISCLAIMER

RISK STATEMENT

It must be recognised that sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the open day, you agree and acknowledge that:

- (i) You are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and you accept responsibility exposing yourself to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the open day;
- (ii) You will comply at all times with the instructions of the Club's Commodore particularly with regard to handling of boats, wearing of buoyancy aids and the wearing of suitable clothing for the conditions;
- (iii) You accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own negligence;
- (iv) You will not participate whilst your ability to skipper or crew a dinghy is impaired by alcohol, drugs or whilst otherwise unfit to participate ;
- (v) The provision of safety boat cover is limited to such assistance, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.

CANCELLATION

You understand that the Commodore may cancel or postpone the event at any stage in the event of bad weather, equipment failure or otherwise.

MISCONDUCT

You understand that the Commodore may exclude anyone from a sailing session and evict anyone from the premises who refuses to comply with these Registration Terms or who misconducts themselves in any way or who causes damage or annoyance to other persons.

PHOTOGRAPHY

We may take photographs and video footage of the event for use by us in connection with the promotion of the Club. Images may be posted on our website and on social media. If you object to the use of these images please let us know.

CONSENT

By taking part you confirm that you have read and fully understand the Registration Terms and agree to comply with them.

PARENTAL/GUARDIAN CONSENT (if under 18)

By allowing your child to take part you confirm that your child may take part in the event. You confirm that you have read through the above conditions with him/her and that she/he understands and agrees with them. You also confirm that he/she takes part with your full agreement.
